WHO WE ARE

The Palisades 4th of July Parade is sponsored and organized by the Palisades Community Association (PCA). The Palisades Neighborhood, hugging the Potomac River bluffs, is considered a “small town within a big city.” 2026 marks the 60th year that the PCA has presented the Palisades 4th of July Parade.

THE 4TH OF JULY PARADE

The PCA endeavors to present a community, family oriented “small town” parade along MacArthur Boulevard in the Palisades with a focus on family friendly participation.

PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES AND COMMITMENT

Participants recognize the community and small-town nature of the Parade and by participating in the Parade agree that it is neither the time nor place for protests, to represent political opinions on sensitive and controversial topics, or to express hate or vitriol of any kind.

In this regard, the PCA will not tolerate any advocacy, display, or distribution of any kind or in any form of hateful or derisive speech, discourse, rhetoric, material or sentiment that attacks, threatens, insults, or degrades a group or individual based on attributes like race, religion, sexual orientation, gender, or disability (“hateful speech”). This includes, without limitation, anti-semitic or anti-Islamic hateful speech.

The PCA, in its sole discretion and judgement, reserves the right to review and approve all applications to participate in the 4th of July Parade and to exclude participation. Should any participant's behavior be deemed inappropriate and counter to the guidelines set forth above, such applicant will not be permitted to participate or shall be asked to immediately leave the parade.
